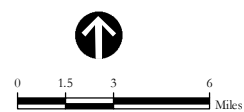
NOTES:

1. FUTURE TRAFFIC CIRCULATION CORRIDORS INDICATE DESIRED TRAVEL CORRIDORS AND DO NOT IMPLY SPECIFIC LOCATION OF FUTURE ROAD ALIGNMENTS. THE CORRIDORS SHOWN ON THIS MAP ARE TO GUIDE DECISIONS REGARDING RIGHT OF WAY PRESERVATION AND PROVIDE A GENERAL, LONG-RANGE UNDERSTANDING OF MOBILITY NEEDS.
2. THE LINES ON THE MAP ARE CONCEPTUAL AND DO NOT DEFINE THE TYPE, WIDTH, OR DESIGN COMPONENTS OF THE FACILITY. MORE DETAILED ANALYSIS SHALL BE CONDUCTED PRIOR TO ANY RIGHT OF WAY AQUSITION.
3. THE COUNTY WILL ENCOURAGE THE ALIGNMENT OF NEW ROADS TO IMPLEMENT THE GENERALIZED CORRIDORS TO MINIMIZE HABITAT AND WETLAND IMPACTS AND UTILIZE EXISTING COUNTY OR PRIVATE ROADS TO THE EXTENT PRACTICAL.
4. ROADS IN THE CITY THAT ARE NOT MAINTAINED BY THE COUNTY ARE SHOWN FOR INFORMATIONAL PURPOSES ONLY.
