A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TAYLOR COUNTY, FLORIDA, HONORING THE MEMORY OF WILBER MILLER, IN RECOGNITION OF SERVICES RENDERED ON BEHALF OF A GRATEFUL NATION AND THE RESIDENTS OF TAYLOR COUNTY, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, with the passing of Wilber Miller a seventeen year employee of Taylor County; and

WHEREAS; Wilber Miller served in the United States Army from 1950 through 1960 and attained the rank of Sergeant First Class; and

WHEREAS, during this period he served with distinction in both the 9th and 10th Calvary as a Buffalo Soldier; and

WHEREAS, his performance in the line of duty during the Korean was unselfish, heroic, and exemplary for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Wilber Miller served in all black units until the Army integrated in 1956; and

WHEREAS, he was a model employee with the Taylor County Road Department; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Board of County Commissioners, and the residents of Taylor County desire to honor his memory and his selfless service on our behalf by passing a resolution honoring his life.
