

RESOLUTION 2011 - N/A

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COUNTY, FLORIDA, ENCOURAGING A ZONE OF DISCHARGE WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COUNTY'S SOLID WASTE LANDFILL.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has approved and permitted the construction of unlined county and municipal landfills in the past; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has approved and permitted the closure of unlined county and municipal landfills in the past; and

WHEREAS, unlined county and municipal landfills may have had minor impact on the groundwater directly under the landfill waste and contained within the landfill property; and

WHEREAS, the groundwater standard for these sites has been the drinking water standard adopted for potable water; and

WHEREAS, the costs of clean-up and addressing other remedial actions required to meet the drinking water standard within the existing landfill boundaries would be prohibitive; and


WHEREAS, groundwater from within the boundaries of the landfill will never be used for drinking water purposes.

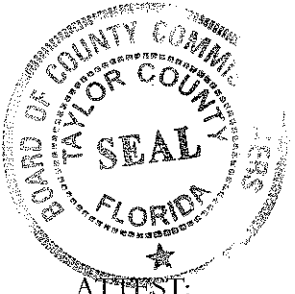
BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED: by the Board of County Commissioners for Taylor County, Florida, as follows:

The Governor and Legislature of the State of Florida are urged to enact legislation to enact legislation to define a Zone of Discharge at each county and municipal landfill as extending to the current or expanded boundary of such landfills. Upon establishment of the Zone of Discharge and demonstration that the degradation will not extend beyond the boundaries of the landfill, no further action be required to meet drinking water standards within the Zone of Discharge.


